»» **Can you give us a short presentation of yourself and your art?**

i am one of those guys who like to draw little funny things during the day whenever a pen and a piece of paper are around. most of my works are linocuts.

»» **How did you get started in the illustration/ art field?**

i grew up in a family where art was always present.

»» **What are you working on right now?**

i'm trying to print linocuts in huge sizes.

»» **What are your favourite tools?**

pen, paper, linoleum.

»» **Please tell us about the process of making the EardrumsPop-cover! Is this the way you usually work?**

i did a sketch, did some cutting, printed it as a linocut and colored it with photoshop. the step with photoshop is unusual for me. in most cases i do prints with up to five overlapping blocks using just black or grey tones.

»» **Who / what are your greatest visual inspirations?**

long trips into nature and long nights in the city.

»» **Is music or other forms of art an inspiration? If so, what do you listen to?**

i always listen to music when i draw or print, and the music i listen to varies a lot.

»» **Describe an average working day.**

4 days a week at the office from 9 to 5. working as a network administrator and software-developer. 3 days off to do whatever i like to do.

- 2) What's the most precious thing you'd smash up or break just for the purpose of taking a photo of it all broken and smashed for this interview?




3) Tell us a secret.

We chose to cover “Jack Of All Trades”, because it is a song we love to play all together. So it felt only natural to ask our friends Henning Kasbohm, Martina Lenzin and Kerstin Pietsch to join in, when we recorded the song. All of us have been through a lot of odd-jobbing to be able to do what we love: Make music, see places, meet people, for instance. This song describes this very feeling – with some sort of megalomaniac, dreamy twist, admittedly. “Consider this a hymn to all the folks with no steady income coming in.”
